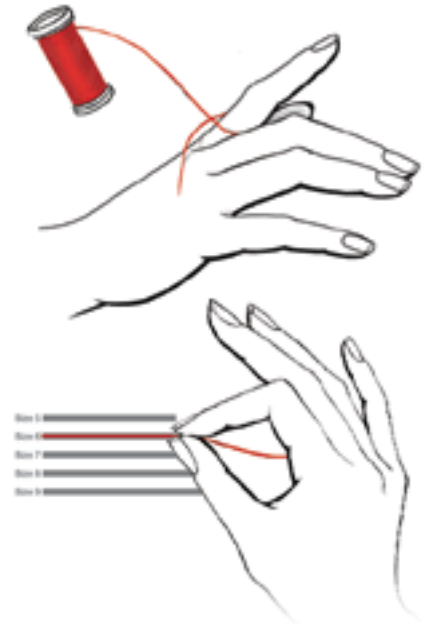

NOTE: For accurate ring size results, please make sure **PAGE SCALING** is set to "NONE" and "Auto-Rotate" is NOT CHECKED. Use the ruler at the bottom of the page to test print calibration.

Finding your ring size

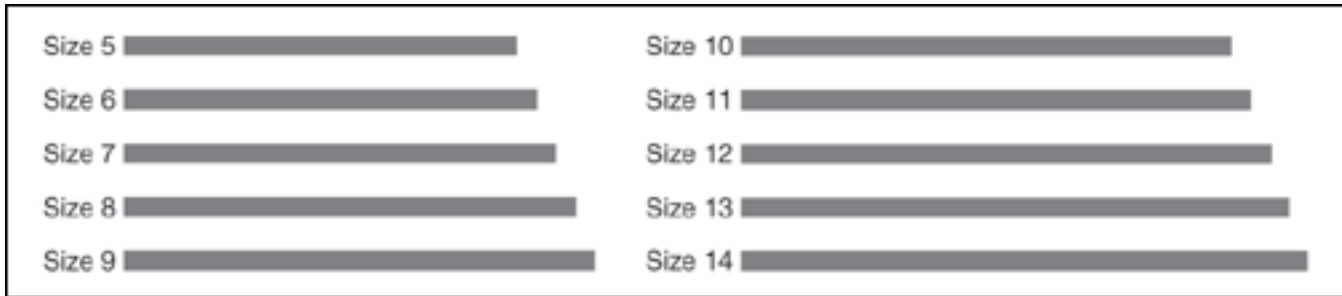
Using sewing thread, yarn, or any string-like material will work in order to measure your ring finger. Simply take the tip or end of the material that you are using and wrap it around your finger until it meets or connects together. Make sure that you then mark that position of the material. Once you have successfully marked the measured position and your fitting is complete you can then move to the next step.



Now place the material over the corresponding ring size scale below. Match the length of your measurement fitting with the appropriate ring size. Once you have completed this you will have your ring size.

*** If you are between sizes, order the half size.**

Measure your finger and compare to this scale

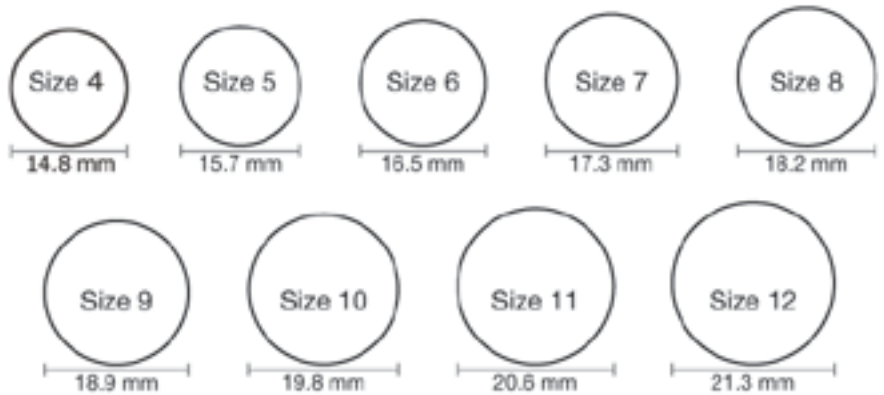


Buying the ring as a surprise?

1. Ask a close friend or relative if they know the ring size of the person that will be accepting the ring.

2. Use another ring that he or she owns with this chart to find out the ring size. (This ring will need fit the ring finger that your gift is meant for.)

3. Take a ring that fits your ring finger and place it over the corresponding circle. You'll need to make sure that the inner part of your ring lines up with the circle. If your ring does not perfectly line up, than it's best to order half size larger.
